Acta Dermato-Venereologica goes Open Access as of January 1, 2011!

OPEN ACCESS

The Society for Publication of Acta Dermato-Venereologica has decided that the journal will go for total open access as of the first issue of 2011. The paper version of the journal will, however, continue to be produced for those who prefer to pay for its subscription. Any submission of manuscripts already since October 1st, 2010, must adhere to the new rules, i.e. payment of a non-refundable submission fee (40 euros per manuscript) and increased page charge, to allow the economy of Acta Dermato-Venereologica to be eventually shifted from being subscription-based to a predominantly author-paid system, withholding the non-profit ideology of the journal.
